### Who we are:

The Casa Italiana Sociocultural Center Inc. (CISC) is a non-profit organization dedicated to promoting Italian American history and culture through various programs, including the Italian American Museum of Washington DC (IAMDC), an Archives collection, a compendium of oral histories, and *Voce Italiana*, an Italian American newspaper. CISC also sponsors events to promote and educate the community on the history and culture of the greater DC area's Italian and Italian American heritage.

The grant will support the archives component of the IAMDC, whose mission is to honor the legacy of Italians and Italian Americans in the Nation's Capital, preserve our history, and celebrate our cultural heritage.

### Who is eligible:

Undergraduate and graduate students attending accredited colleges and universities who will be living in the DC metropolitan area this summer, within commuting distance of the Italian American Museum of DC (IAMDC).

Applicants must be available to work 15 to 20 hours per week in the Archives Office of the IAMDC (three or four days per week, flexible hours Monday through Thursday). The term of the grant is June through September 30th.

While students majoring in library sciences or history are preferred, we are welcoming applications from students in all academic programs.

Knowledge of Italian is required for this initial phase of the Archives Project.

### Terms of the Grant:

- 1. The Archives Project Director (the CEO of CISC, Inc.) and the selected student will jointly develop a work plan to produce a professional database of a collection of papers using either Excel or Microsoft Access. Specifically, the student will inventory the Pino Cicala Collection which consists of around 300 file folders, which have been already indexed and posted online at <a href="https://www.casaitalianacenter.org/cisc-archives">https://www.casaitalianacenter.org/cisc-archives</a>. These folders contain clips, notes, newsletters, articles, etc., which pertain mostly to the Italian American community in the Washington DC area. The student will work independently under the guidance of the Archives Director.
- 2. Time schedules and deadlines will be coordinated at the outset. Expectation is a flexible schedule [four to six hours per day, three or four days per week (Monday through Thursday) until work is completed by or before September 30th.
- 3. CISC-IAMDC holds the rights to all the recipient's IAMDC work. Any use of the museum's copyrighted material must be approved by CISC-IAMDC in advance.
- 4. The student will be paid a \$5,000 stipend in four installments of \$1,250 over the course of the grant. All work agreed to in the plan must be satisfactorily completed before the final installment is paid. The four work completion points will be agreed upon with the Archives Project Director.
- 5. CISC will issue an IRS Form 1099. Any tax implications are the recipient's responsibility.

#### **Desired Skills:**

- Excellent research, writing and organizational skills, especially attention to detail. Ability to work independently.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office (Excel and/or Access).
- Course work or experience in library sciences, collections management or archiving a plus, but not required.
- Proficiency in Italian is required, as many of the documents included in the collection are in Italian.

### **Required Documents:**

Please submit a copy of your *resume* and a *transcript* from your college/university (an unofficial transcript is acceptable).
